THINK FOOD PANTRY REMINDER

Following are essential item needed to supply a family of varying sizes.

- 1 lb bags of rice
- 12-16 oz packages of pasta
- 1# & 2# cans of fruit, some diabetic
- Canned condensed soups, any
- Canned meats: ham, tuna, chicken
- Cereal, hot & cold type, boxed or bags
- Baking mixes of any size and type
- Flour, sugar, evap or dried milk, oils
- Gelatin & pudding mixes, some sugar free
- Packaged dry meal mixes, or side dishes, like Ramen, Lipton, Knorr, etc.
- Peanut butter & jelly
- Bread, crackers, taco shells, etc
- Any type of tomato product: sauce, diced, etc.
- Fruit & vegetable juices, shelf stable container
- Beans, both dried & canned, whole or refried
- Canned vegetables of all kinds
- Limited amount of baby food
